BASIC OBJECTIVES

This is specialized fleet operation work, assisting with the operation of a Driver Training Program for Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) School Bus Drivers. This work involves developing and conducting driver training and retraining programs, exceptional student bus aid training, and other in-service training for employee development and safety.

JOB TASKS/RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Instructs and trains school bus driver trainees to comply with 40-hour State approved training syllabus.
- 2. Assists Transportation Training Manager in developing and conducting inservice training.
- 3. Serves on the Accident Review Board and maintains all records pertaining to the Board's action.
- 4. Organizes and conducts the local "School Bus Driver's Road-e-o".
- 5. Monitors_the performance of drivers at Regional Transportation Centers, as required.
- 6. Conducts reflex testing on all bus drivers, as required.
- 7. Conducts two (2) day Commercial Driver's License (CDL) written exam preparation class.
- 8. Prepares trainees and vehicle maintenance employees for the CDL skills test.
- 9. Conducts retraining and maintains records of school bus drivers referred by the Accident Review Committee or Regional Center Directors.

- 10. Assists the Transportation Training Manager in conducting the National Safety Councils DDC.
- 11. Assists the Transportation Training Manager in providing Hepatitis "B" awareness class.
- 12. Assists in coordinating, evaluation and training for the K-4 program.
- 13. Conducts school bus aide training class, including wheelchair securing, hydraulic lift operation of safety vests and child safety restraint seats.
- 14. Conducts Commercial Driver's License skills test for school bus driver trainees and vehicle maintenance employees, as required.
- 15. Prepares and maintains training records for all drivers training and retraining.
- 16. Performs related work, as required or as assigned.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

This is medium work which requires the following physical activities: climbing, balancing, twisting, reaching, sitting, standing, walking, pushing, pulling, lifting, finger dexterity, grasping, talking, feeling, repetitive motions, hearing and visual acuity. The worker is exposed to noise, vibrations, and hazards. The work is performed indoors and outdoors.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Graduation from high school or an equivalent recognized certificate, supplemented by college-level coursework in education, transportation management or related discipline.
- 2. Must have three (3) years bus driver experience.
- 3. Employee will be expected to acquire a Florida School Bus Driver's Trainer Certificate and Driver Education Certificate, as determined by the Department of Transportation.
- 4. Must have a valid Florida Commercial Driver's License (Class A or B) with passenger and school bus endorsement.
- 5. Must maintain a valid Medical Examiner Certificate ESE 479.
- 6. Ability to become certified as a third party CDL examiner within 90 days of employment.

Note: This is an Omnibus Transportation Employees Testing Act (OTETA) monitored position. Employees with this job description may be required to drive or road test a motor vehicle weighing over 26,000 pounds, transport 16 or more persons, or carry hazardous materials.
