### **BASIC OBJECTIVES**

This is specialized fleet operation work, assisting with the operation of a Driver Training Program for Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) School Bus Drivers. This work normally involves developing and conducting driver training and retraining programs with emphasis on the State required Commercial Driver's License (CDL) testing program, and other in-service training for employee development and safety. Work is performed under the general supervision of the Coordinator II, Transportation Operations and Training and the Transportation Training Manager.

### JOB TASKS/RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Trains school bus drivers to comply with State required Commercial Driver's License requirements to include both the written examination and skills test.
- 2. Supervises subordinate instructors.
- 3. Assists Transportation Training Manager in developing and conducting in-service training.
- 4. Assists in organizing and conducting the local "School Bus Drivers' Road-e-o",
- 5. Tests and maintains records for driver training programs.
- 6. Evaluates drivers' performance.
- 7. Conducts reflex testing for bus drivers, as required.
- 8. Substitutes as School Bus Driver Trainer, job code 6273, and Bus Attendant Trainer, as required.
- 9. Conducts Commercial Driver's License skills test for school bus driver trainees and vehicle maintenance employees.
- 10. Assists Transportation Training Manager in conducting the National Safety Council DDC course.
- 11. Serves on the Accident Review Board and maintains records.
- 12. Maintains State required Third Party Test records.
- 13. Administers final check ride to school bus driver trainees.

- 14. Creates and maintains training files.
- 15. Prepares training materials, handouts and study guides.
- 16. Performs related work, as required or as assigned.

# PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

This is light medium work which requires the following physical activities: climbing, balancing, bending, stooping, kneeling, crouching, twisting, reaching, sitting, standing, walking, pushing, pulling, lifting, finger dexterity, grasping, feeling, repetitive motions, talking, hearing and visual acuity. The worker is exposed to noise, vibrations and hazards. The work is performed indoors and outdoors.

# MINIMUM QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Graduation from high school or an equivalent recognized certificate, supplemented by college-level coursework in education, transportation management or related discipline.
- 2. Must have three (3) years experience as a bus driver and a minimum of one year (1) experience as an M-DCPS Driver Trainer.
- 3. Employee will be expected to acquire a Florida School Bus Driver Certificate and a Florida School Bus Driver's Trainer Certificate at a designated time.
- 4. Ability to become certified as a third party CDL Examiner within 90 days of employment.
- 5. Must have a valid Florida Commercial Driver's License (Class A or B) with a passenger and school bus endorsement.
- 6. Must maintain a valid Medical Examiner Certificate ESE 479.
- 7. Must have effective written and verbal communication skills.
- Note: This is an Omnibus Transportation Employees Testing Act (OTETA) monitored position. Employees with this job description may be required to drive or road test a motor vehicle weighing over 26,000 pounds, transport 16 or more persons, or carry hazardous materials.
