BASIC OBJECTIVES

This is general labor work involving the performance of a wide variety of tasks associated with M-DCPS construction and general maintenance activities. The work involves the exercise of independent judgement and initiative to complete assigned tasks, applying specific knowledge of construction and/or maintenance methods and practices.

JOB TASKS/RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Operates hand equipment to construct or repair storm drains, drain lines, catch basins, curbs, sidewalks, road ways and playgrounds.
- 2. Spreads, levels, and grades asphalt for roadway construction.
- 3. Cuts and prunes trees, plants and shrubs; lays sod, plants, seeds, and applies fertilizers and herbicides.
- 4. Spreads, levels and prepares soil for planting and paving.
- 5. Moves, loads, and unloads materials, equipment and supplies.
- 6. Operates medium or large (26,000 LBST) trucks (dump, flatbed, stake body) to transport building and construction materials, furniture, equipment and supplies.
- 7. Follows general instructions, standard practices and procedures and all established driving, operating and safety rules and regulations to operate equipment.
- 8. Performs related work as required or as assigned.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

This is very heavy work which requires the following physical activities: climbing, bending, stooping, kneeling, twisting, reaching, sitting, standing, walking, pushing, pulling, lifting, grasping, repetitive motions, talking, hearing and visual acuity. The worker is exposed to heat, noise, hazards, atmospheric conditions, and oils. The work is performed indoors and outdoors.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Completion of eighth grade and demonstrated ability to read, write and understand written instructions. High school diploma or equivalent is preferred.
- 2. Six months experience in general construction or facilities grounds maintenance.
- 3. Possession of a valid Florida CDL Class B driver's license with air brake endorsement.
- 4. Satisfactory completion of a physical examination prior to hire date.

Note: This is an Omnibus Transportation Employees Testing Act (OTETA) monitored position. Employees with this job description may be required to drive or road test a motor vehicle weighing over 26,000 pounds, transport 16 or more persons, or carry hazardous materials.
