#### BASIC OBJECTIVES

Sheet Metal Worker II (Journeyperson) performs skilled work independently under the guidance of a Foreperson or other supervisory personnel and in accordance with the standard practices of the sheet metal trade. Journeyperson level work includes, but is not limited:

- laying out, fabricating, installing, altering, maintaining, and repairing sheet metal associated with a component of, or the principal physical plant, and all related equipment;
- using knowledge and experience of the trade to determine a method or to devise a means to accomplish the assigned job; and
- interpreting technical data from sketches, blueprints, schematics and service manuals.

### JOB TASKS/RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Performs tasks by utilizing the standard tools, materials, codes, methods and safe practices of the sheet metal trade.
- 2. Operates power driven machinery such as brakes, shears, rollers, grinders, formers, notchers, and drill presses.
- 3. Shapes sheet metal products to comply with close tolerances and to conform with an existing or specified condition.
- 4. Joins work by soldering, welding, riveting or by the use of other fasteners.
- 5. Applies insulation materials to fabrications.
- 6. Performs assignments that include the use of different types of ladders, scaffolds, and/or other equipment.
- 7. Determines materials and equipment required and oversees their use, security and disposition.
- 8. Maintains records regarding materials, equipment, and job assignments.

- 9. Directs work of assigned staff.
- 10. Ensures that assignments are completed in conformance with instructions and applicable codes in a timely and cost effective manner.
- 11. Stays current with codes and technological methods and advances of this trade.
- 12. May operate M-DCPS or personal vehicle for functions outlined in job description and to locations specified by work orders or as otherwise directed.
- 13. Performs other related tasks as instructed.

# PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

This is heavy work which requires the following physical activities: climbing, balancing, bending, stooping, kneeling, crouching, crawling, twisting, reaching, sitting, standing, walking, pushing, pulling, lifting, finger dexterity, grasping, feeling, repetitive motions, talking, hearing and visual acuity. The worker is exposed to heat, noise, hazards, atmospheric conditions, oils and is required to wear a respirator. The work is performed indoors and outdoors.

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Written evidence of graduation from high school or equivalent, or GED certification.
- 2. Ability to read, write and understand oral and written instructions.
- 3. Acceptable written evidence of a minimum of four (4) years of diversified experience in the sheet metal trade, including either two (2) years experience as a certified Journeyperson welder or successful completion of an acceptable formal training program.
- 4. Possession of a valid Certificate of Competency is required as a Licensed Journeyperson from either Miami-Dade, Broward, Monroe, Collier or Palm Beach County.
- 5. Successful completion of the applicable trade M-DCPS skills test. (6400)
- 6. Possession of a valid Florida Class E driver's license.
- 5. Satisfactory completion of physical examination prior to hire date.
