BASIC OBJECTIVES

Painter II (Journey person) will work independently under the guidance of a Foreperson or other supervisory personnel and in accordance with the standard practices of the paint trade. Journey person level work includes, but is not limited to:

- assisting in the preparation, application and maintenance of paint, stain, or other dressings on interior, and/or exterior surfaces of buildings, equipment or other items;
- using knowledge and experience of the trade to determine a method or to devise a means to accomplish the assigned job; and
- interpreting technical data from sketches, blueprints, schematics and service manuals.

JOB TASKS/RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Performs tasks by utilizing the standard tools, materials, codes, methods and safe practices of the paint trade.
2. Prepares a variety of different types of surfaces using manual and/or mechanical methods incorporating the tools and appropriate materials.
3. Caulks, seals, and fills voids in surfaces and around windows, doors, and other openings in buildings using the appropriate materials as part of the preparatory work. Scrubs and/or sands surfaces to receive paint.
4. Mixes and/or matches paints or stains to conform with existing or specified colors.
5. Applies paint, stain, or other dressings to a variety of surfaces using manual/or mechanical methods.
6. Performs task assignments that include the use of different types of ladders, scaffolds, and other equipment.

7. Determines materials and equipment required and oversees their use, security, and disposition.
8. Maintains records regarding materials, equipment, and job assignments.
9. Directs work of assigned staff.
10. Ensures that assignments are completed in conformance with instructions and applicable codes in a timely and cost effective manner.
11. Stays current with codes and technological methods and advances of this trade.
12. May operate M-DCPS or personal vehicle for functions outlined in job description and to locations specified by work orders or as otherwise directed.
13. Performs other related tasks as instructed.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

This is heavy work which requires the following physical activities: climbing, balancing, bending, stooping, crouching, kneeling, crawling, twisting, reaching, sitting, standing, walking, pushing, pulling, lifting, finger dexterity, feeling, grasping, repetitive motions, talking, hearing and visual acuity. The worker is exposed to noise, vibration, hazards, atmospheric conditions, oils and is required to wear a respirator. The work is performed indoors and outdoors and includes working from heights, assorted ladders, scaffolds, swing stages, and assorted mechanical lifts.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Written evidence of graduation from high school or equivalent.
2. Ability to read, write, and understand oral and written instructions.
3. Acceptable written evidence of a minimum of four (4) years of diversified experience in the painting trade, including either two (2) years experience as a Journeyperson or successful completion of an acceptable formal training program.
4. Successful completion of the applicable trade M-DCPS skills test. (6350)
5. Possession of a valid Florida Class E driver's license.
6. Satisfactory completion of a physical examination prior to hire date.
